Advanced Honors Classes in 10th Grade

If you: 1) have a 'B' or higher in your 9th grade math, English or science classes; 2) have a teacher's recommendation; and 3) are one of the top 24 ranked students who wish to enroll in a Sophomore honor's class, you can take Advanced Algebra II, Advanced English 10 and/or Advanced Biology. Otherwise, you will be placed in Algebra II, English 10 and/or Biology.

Please note, based on your: 1) pre-registration requests for these classes; 2) your course-specific grades; 3) your class rank; and 4) teacher recommendation, **your APPROVED English, Math, and Science classes have been circled for you.** If you believe this in error, please see Mr. Longerbone and Ms. Anderson.

All other courses have been circled based on your pre-registration requests. You are free to change your mind about any of these but note, subject to space availability (juniors and seniors register first), your request may or may not be granted.

Due to class size caps, students will not likely be allowed to register for more than two quarters of a PE Elective during 5th period. Keep in mind, you will have PE 10 every day in your schedule during semester two.
