Please note, if you are in Choir (an 'A' day course), you would also need to choose a 'B' day course to finish off your schedule **in every** quarter or semester. If you are in Band (a 'B' day course), you would also need to choose an 'A' day class to finish off your schedule **in every** quarter or semester. If you are **NOT** in Band or Choir, you must select from classes that meet on 'AB' days only.

Students who are **NOT** in <u>BOTH</u> BAND and CHOIR must take at least <u>one</u> quarter of <u>Applied Programming</u>** and <u>one</u> quarter of <u>Computer Technology 9</u>**. Doing so is a way to fulfill the Computer/Technology requirement for graduation. It is highly suggested that <u>non-music</u> students take at least one Art class as well (e.g. Drawing, Graphic Design, Sculpture, or Textile Arts/Quilting). Students must earn one credit in the Arts as part of their graduation requirements (Band and Choir also count towards an Art credit). Due to class size caps, students will not be allowed to register for more than two quarters of a PE Elective during 5th period. Remember, you will have PE 9 in your schedule already (every day in semester two). Please note, if you select PE in quarter 3, you will have two PE classes a day in that quarter. **If students register for Textile Arts/Quilting, they only have to take one of the following: Applied Programming <u>and NOT</u> Computer Technology 9.
