

## Registration Information: 2024-2025

- 1) Review your scheduling options with a parent or guardian. Remember, you can change your mind about the classes you selected during your pre-registration meeting with Ms. Anderson. Everything on your form has been written in pencil and can be easily erased. Just keep your graduation requirements in mind.
  
- 2) Any student wanting to be a Teacher Assistant (TA) will need to complete an application form and apply to an open position. If invited, you will then take part in an interview. Students who earn a TA position will be required to take 'Workplace Readiness' training during WIN this spring. See Ms. Anderson if you have any questions about this.
  
- 3) If you are taking an online college course, there is an additional form for a parent/guardian to sign.
  
- 4) Make sure to have a parent/guardian sign your registration form.
  
- 5) Return your signed registration form to the office by March 7th, 2024 (there will be a table outside of Missy's window with a grade-specific box for you to place this in).

Please note, if you didn't pre-select one of these options when you met with Ms. Anderson, they are now FULL. If you want to change your schedule so you can take one of them, you won't be able to unless someone else drops it from their schedule.

- Quarters 1 and 2 (Welding)---6th and 7th periods

- Semester 1 (Apparel/Textiles/Design)---5th period
- Semester 2 (Textile Arts/Quilting)---5th period
- Semester 2 (Small Engines)---5th period
