The CARLSON FAMILY COMMUNITY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a MCC senior who will be attending college. This scholarship emphasizes the importance of community service, leadership, and making a positive impact in the community while getting life experience that will help one develop as a person as well.

An award of \$400 will be disbursed in the scholarship recipient's second semester of college upon successful completion of his/her first semester classes (verified through a first semester college transcript).

Procedure: Submit a typed letter to the scholarship committee. The letter should include:

- A. Why you should be awarded this scholarship
- B. Community service activities you have participated in within the community (e.g. civic groups, churches, and/or other)
- C. High School accomplishments in academics and extracurricular areas
- D. Future plans beyond high school, including the post-secondary school you will be attending next year and your career aspirations
- E. Any additional information you would like to share with the committee about your journey, goals and dreams

Please note, GPA and class rank will also be considered.
