

Lloyd Melvie Aviation Scholarship

In the spring of each school year, beginning in 2019, The Lloyd Melvie Aviation Scholarship will be awarding a \$ 2,000 Scholarship to a graduating high school senior from Marshall County Central High School. This Scholarship will be a payout directly to the winning individual to assist the selected person in pursuing any career related to aviation. All applicants must meet the qualifications stipulated below and applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. To be considered the applicant must meet the following qualifications:

- **Applicants should be a graduating senior of Marshall County Central High School.**
- **Applicants must have a minimum of 3.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average.**
 - **Transcript must be included for application to be considered.**
- **Applicants must have intent to pursue a career in aviation. Including but not limited to:**
 - **Air Traffic Controller**
 - **Air Craft Maintenance**
 - **Airport Management**
 - **Aviation Business Administration**
 - **Aviation Management**
 - **Maintenance Management**
 - **Professional Pilot**
 - **Un-Manned Aerial System**

Payment:

- Scholarship recipient must provide a copy of the paid tuition bill, for aviation related courses, to the MCC Education Foundation Scholarship Committee. At that time, a check will be issued for the scholarship amount.

Procedure:

- Each applicant is asked to fill out the attached application,
- Submit a transcript and write an essay using the prompt below:
 - **"Explain why you are pursuing a career in Aviation and what are your future goals regarding aviation."**

Applications are due on or before Mar 30. Questions, applications, essays and transcripts should be submitted to: mcceducationfund@mccfreeze.org or hand written copies presented at the school office indicating it is for the MCC Education Foundaton. Please include your first and last name and scholarship application in the subject line and have your application submitted as a PDF or word document; example: "John/Jane Smith Scholarship Application". The scholarship winner will be determined by the MCC Education Foundation scholarship committee and will be announced during Senior Awards Night.
