

Margot Dahl Scholarship Information

Margot Dahl taught high school English and Spanish at Marshall County Central for sixteen years. She was a teacher who strived to help students achieve excellence in all aspects of their lives. Academic excellence was very important to her, but she also believed that students should become active in their school and community. She hoped that students would participate in service activities and hold leadership roles.

Seniors achieving a **3.0 grade point average or higher** are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

This scholarship is not based on financial need. It is based on academic achievements, community and service involvement, and leadership.

Procedure:

Eligible students must submit a **typed** essay that includes the following:

1. Write about **one** high school accomplishment in academics and explain the importance to you.
2. Write about **one** participation in service and community activity and explain the impact it had on you.
3. Write about **one** leadership position in school or community service activity and explain how the skills you learned can be used in the future.

LETTERS AND THIS FORM ARE TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELING OFFICE. THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION (essay and this form) IS **Friday, May 1, 2020**.
