

# MARK CARLSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is in memory of Mark Carlson who served on the MCC School Board from July 1980-May 2018. Mr. Carlson was dedicated to the MCC School District, students and staff. He was also a champion for early childhood intervention. This scholarship is open to all seniors who will be attending a post-secondary school following graduation. Students who will be majoring in education, specifically in the fields of Early Childhood or Special Education are strongly encouraged to apply.

The scholarship money will be disbursed in the recipient's second semester of college upon successful completion of his/her first semester classes (verified through a first semester college transcript).

- A. Why you should be awarded this scholarship
- B. Service activities you have participated in (e.g. civic groups, church, at school, and/or other)
- C. High School accomplishments in academics and extracurricular areas
- D. Future plans beyond high school, including the post-secondary school you will be attending next year and your career aspirations
- E. Any additional information you would like to share with the committee about your journey, goals and dreams

**Please note, GPA and class rank will also be considered.**
